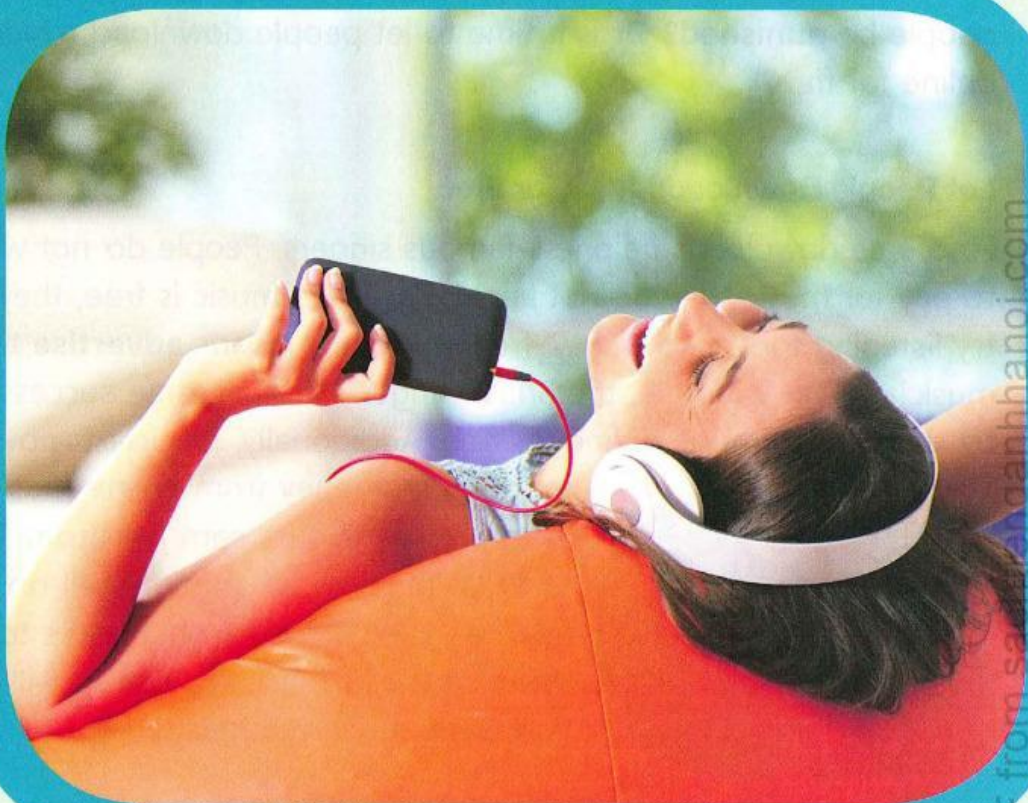

Introducing the Topic

In 1999, Napster became one of the first ways people could download free music. However, most of the downloads were not legal. So Napster had to stop its service. Years later, Apple made iTunes. People pay to download music legally with this. Today, there are many sites that let people buy music on the Internet. But some people still want free music downloads.

Let People Download Music for Free

First, free downloads help less famous singers. People do not want to pay for music they do not know. But if the music is free, they will try listening to it. In this way, free music downloads **advertise** these musicians. For example, the British singer Adele became successful by sharing her music online for free. Additionally, musicians do not



make much money from online music sales anyway. Artists earn just from \$0.30 to \$1.00 for each album they sell on the Internet. Even if they allow people to download their music for free, it will not hurt them much **financially**.

Make People Pay to Download Music

For one, paying for music is a way to reward music artists. They spend lots of time and energy making music. So it is only fair to pay them for their work. In this way, they are also more likely to make more music in the future. Second, downloading music without paying is **stealing**. In our society, if you want something, you need to spend money to get it. For example, if you want a bicycle, you cannot just take it. You must pay for it. Downloading music without paying for it is the same.
