

Notice that with inverted negative conditionals, we can't use contractions:

If she doesn't phone soon, we'll have to leave

Should she not phone soon, we'll have to leave.

NOT ~~Shouldn't she phone, ...~~

If he wasn't a diplomat, he wouldn't have immunity.

Were he not a diplomat, he wouldn't have immunity.

NOT ~~Weren't he a diplomat, ...~~

If he hadn't told me himself, I'd never have believed him.

Had he not told me himself, I'd never have believed him.

NOT ~~Hadn't he told me himself, ...~~
