- A \_\_\_\_\_ is a set of connected or related things.
- A \_\_\_\_\_ is an object with short pieces of stiff hair, plastic, or wire attached to a base or handle, used for cleaning, arranging your hair, or painting.
- A \_\_\_\_\_ is the flat part of the body that a bird, insect, or bat uses for flying, or one of the flat, horizontal structures that stick out from the side of an aircraft and support it when it is flying.
