Part		Function	Example sentences
Greeting		Opening, saying hello	Hi Peter, Hello Peter,
Body	Reason	Say why you want your friend to come	I want you to come because it will be fun! It's more exciting with you!
	Activity	Explain what you will do at the club	We will paint and draw animals. We'll learn new art skills together.
	Suggestion	Suggest how to get back home after the club	We can walk home together. Let's take the bus after the club.
Closing		Ending the email, saying goodbye	See you soon! Your friend, Anna / Jack / [Your name]

A. GRAMMAR: Past simple (Quá khứ đơn)

- Thì quá khứ đơn dùng để diễn tả hành động đã xảy ra và kết thúc trong quá khứ.
- Dấu hiệu nhận biết: yesterday, last week, last year, ago...

	Khẳng định	Phủ định	Nghi vấn
Động từ thường	S + Ved/2 Ví dụ: He ate cookies.	S + didn't + V-inf Ví dụ: I didn't complete the homework.	Did + S + V-inf? → Yes, S did . → No, S didn't . Ví dụ: Did they drive to school? → Yes, they did . → No, they didn't .
Động từ to be	S + was/were Ví dụ: I was a teacher.	S + wasn't/weren't Ví dụ: They weren't at school.	Was/Were + S? → Yes, S was/were . → No, S wasn't/weren't . Ví dụ: Were you sick? → Yes, I was . → No, I wasn't .

Note: S = subject: chủ ngữ; **V-inf** = verb infinitive: động từ nguyên thể; **Ved/2** = past form of Verb: quá khứ của động từ; didn't = did not; wasn't = was not; weren't = were not.

- Có 2 cách chia động từ ở thì quá khứ:

	Cách chia	Ví dụ
Regular verbs (Động từ có quy tắc)	Thêm -ed vào cuối động từ	play → played watch → watched clean → cleaned
Irregular verbs (Động từ bất quy tắc)	Không thêm -ed , mà có hình thức riêng trong quá khứ	go → went eat → ate have → had
