Do you know how to make a fried egg? It's simple and fun! First, you need some things: one egg, a frying pan, a little oil or butter, and a plate.



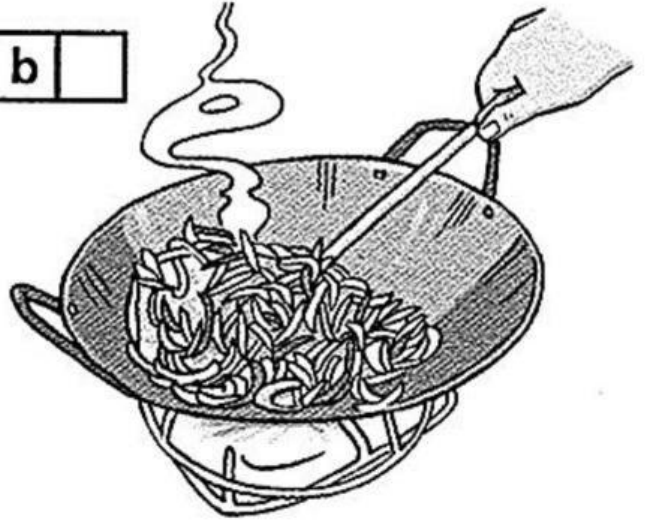
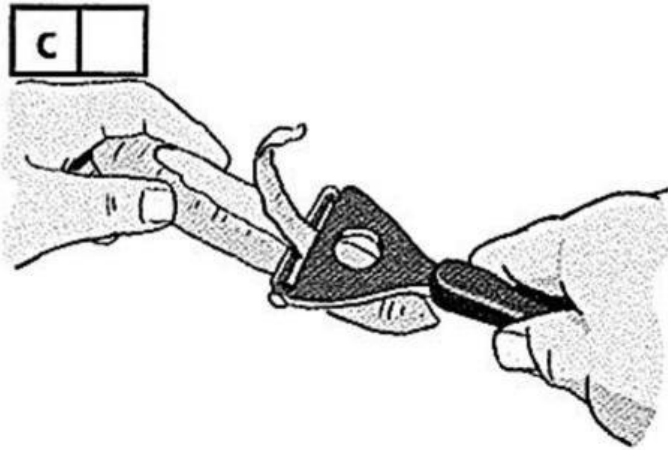
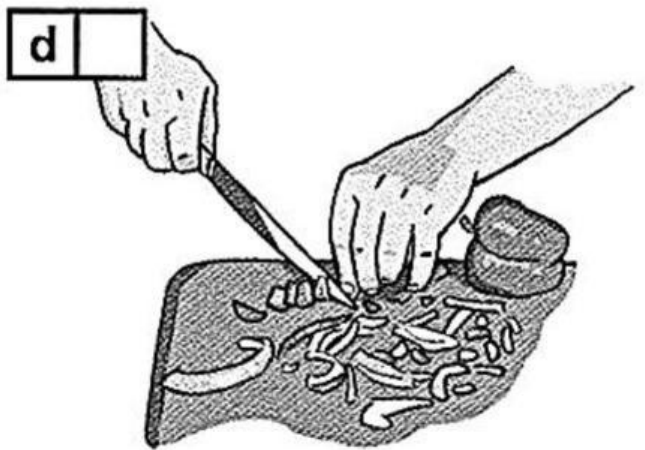
