

Types of Houses

Match the following types of houses with the corresponding description:

A. COTTAGE

1. A one roomed unit of accommodation consisting of a combined bedroom and sitting room with cooking facilities;

B. TERRACED HOUSE

2. A boat which is used for sailing and for dwelling as well;

C. BEDSIT

3. A house attached to a farm;

D. HOUSEBOAT

4. A small house typically one in the country; most of them with a thatched roof;

E. BUNGALOW

5. A house that is situated in a long row of houses; they all usually look the same; both sides of each house in the row share common walls;

F. FLAT

6. A pair of houses joined together by a common wall; this type of housing is called a duplex

G. FARMHOUSE

7. A low house having only one storey or, in some cases, upper rooms set in the roof;

H. PENTHOUSE

8. Also called apartment in AmE., is a living area that is part of a building called block of flats;

I. DETACHED

9. A single free standing residential unit built on a lot; an independent building

J. SEMI-DETACHED

10. A flat on the top floor of a tall building, typically one that is luxurious fitted.
