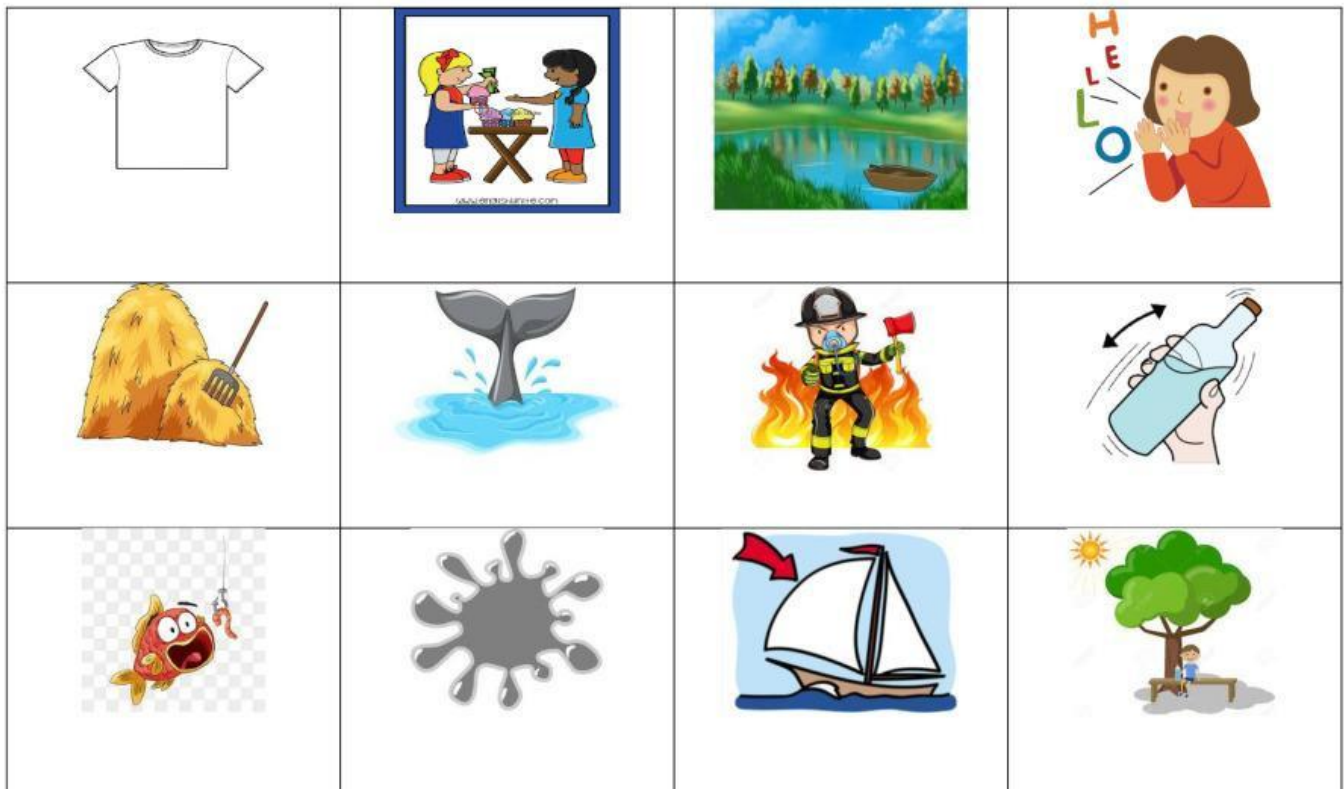


SUMMER REVISION: LONG VOWEL A (a e- ai- ay)
