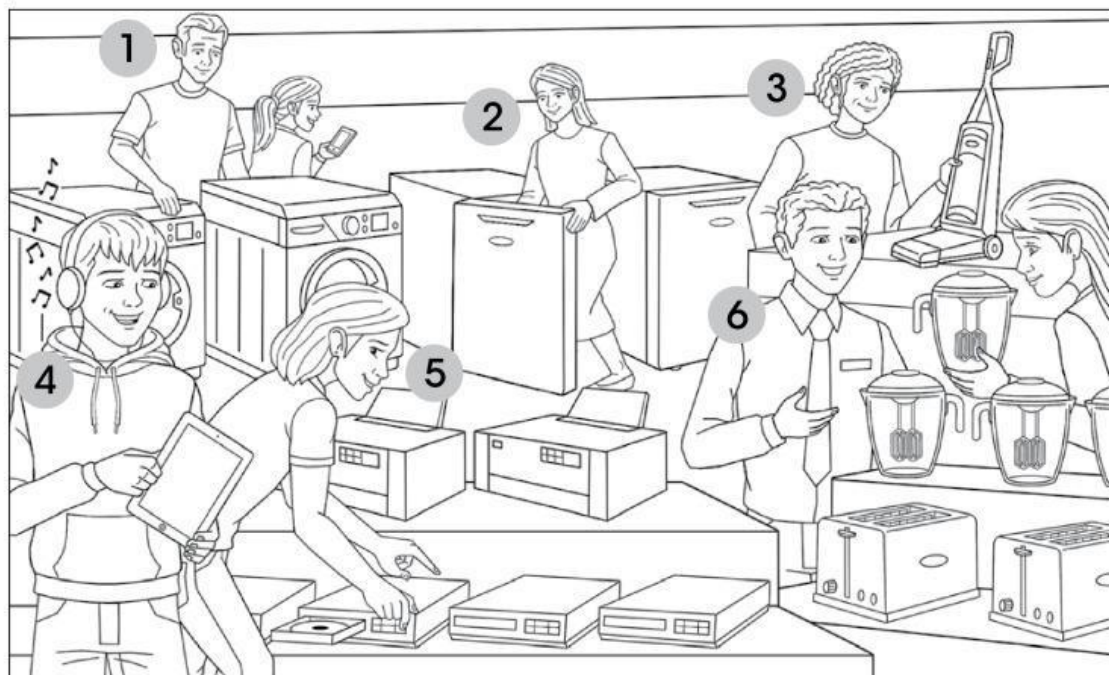

The California Gold Rush

Between 1848 and 1855, lots of people travelled to California to look for gold. They wanted to become rich. The first person who discovered gold was James Marshall. He found it in a river near the city of Coloma. He tried to keep it a secret, but soon a lot of people knew about it.

Before the gold rush, there were more than 10,000 people living in California. In 1848, about 6,000 people arrived. They came from many different places in the world.
