### Adjectives with "er" and "est"

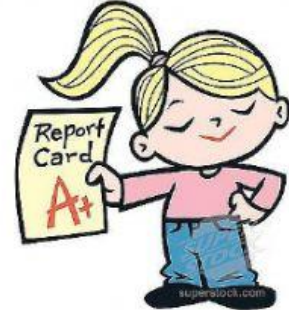
Remember:
