

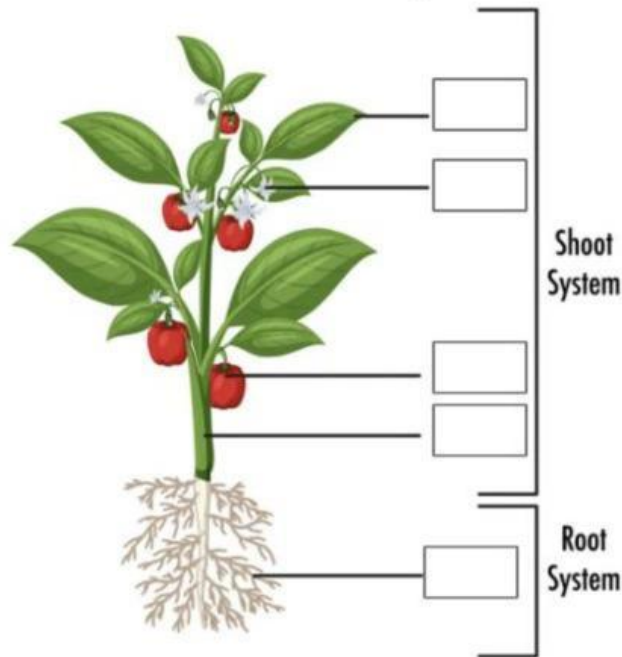

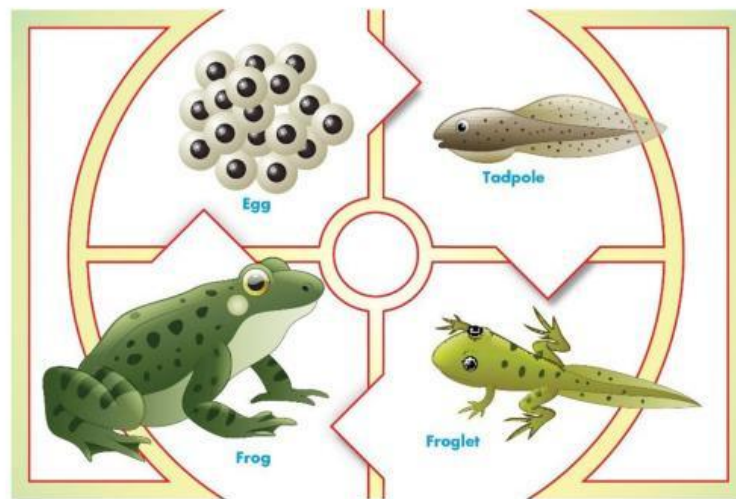

C. Reading



A frog has four main stages in its life. First, the mother frog lays eggs in the water. The eggs are small and round.

Second, the eggs hatch and become tadpoles. Tadpoles live in the water. They have long tails and no legs.

Third, the tadpoles grow legs. They become froglets. Froglets look like small frogs but still have short tails.

Last, the froglet becomes an adult frog. The tail is gone. The adult frog can live on land and in water. Then the life cycle starts again.

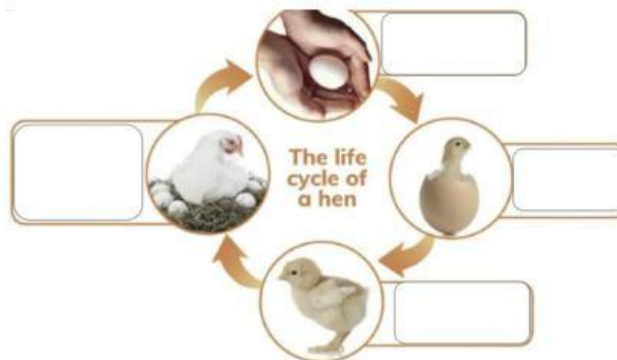
