### Purpose of Narrative Text

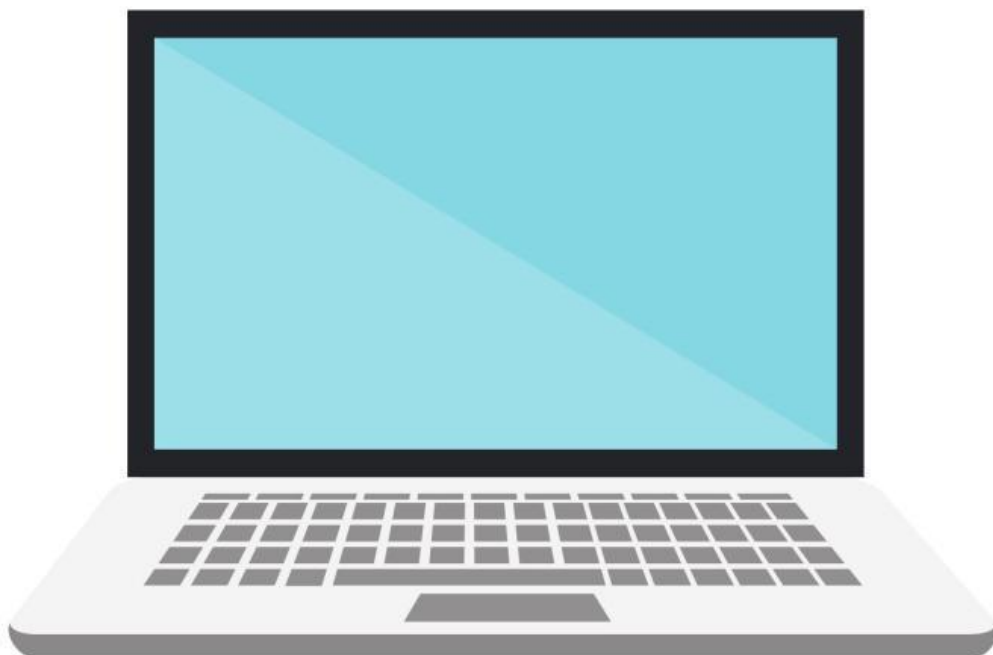
The purpose of narrative text is to entertain or to give information. It can teach people with moral values

### Generic Structure

Basically, a narrative text consist of the following parts :

1. Orientation: sets, the scene and introduces the characters.
2. Complication: provides problems faced by the characters.
3. Resolution, states how the problems are solved, for ebetter or worse.
4. Optional): conclude the story.
