

## What Are Subject and Object Pronouns?

Pronouns are words that take the place of nouns. They help us avoid repeating the same nouns again and again.

The Subject Pronouns do the action in a sentence. (I, you, he, she, it, we, they)

Examples:

- He runs fast.
- They are playing soccer.
- We love reading books.

The Object Pronouns receive the action in a sentence. (me, you, him, her, it, us, them)

Examples:

- The teacher helped me.
- I saw her at the park.
- They invited us to the party.
