

The Monster

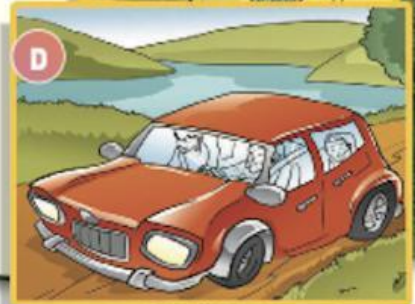
