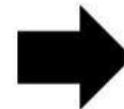
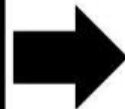
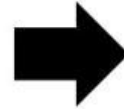
Part 1: Smell and Tell (with Pictures)

Look at each picture. Circle 😊 Pleasant or ☹️ Unpleasant. Then choose what you should do.





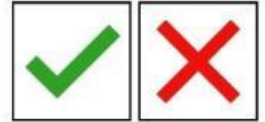




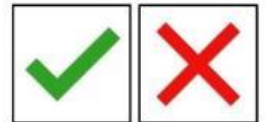

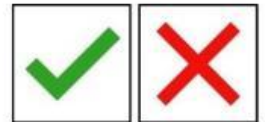
1. We should **throw away** food that smells bad.



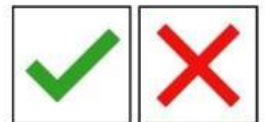
2. If my **socks smell bad**, I should keep wearing them.
