

Reading Worksheet: The Founding Figures of Pancasila

Level: Grade 4

Text for Reading (Teacher Reads or Students Read Aloud)

Before Indonesia became independent, a group called **BPUPK** was formed in 1945. This group met to talk about **how to build a free country**. The meeting was led by **Dr. Radjiman Wedyodiningrat**. There were **Indonesian** and **Japanese** members, but only Indonesians could vote.

In that meeting, three important figures—**Mohammad Yamin**, **Soepomo**, and **Sukarno**—shared their ideas. Later, a smaller group called the **Committee of Nine** was formed. This group included **Sukarno** and **Mohammad Hatta**, and they wrote a draft of the country's rules, called the **Jakarta Charter**.

After independence, another group called **PPKI** made the final decision: **Pancasila** would be the foundation of the Indonesian state.
