Trojan Horse

The Trojan Horse is a story from the Trojan War about the subterfuge that the Greeks (28)_____to enter the independent city of Troy and win the war. The Greeks pretended to sail away, and the Trojans (30)_____the horse into their city as a victory trophy. The Greeks entered and destroyed the city of Troy, (32) _____the war. Metaphorically, a "Trojan Horse" has come to mean any trick or stratagem that causes a target to invite a foe into a securely protected bastion or place.
