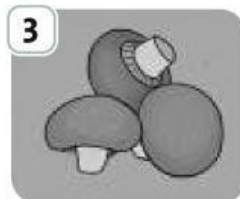

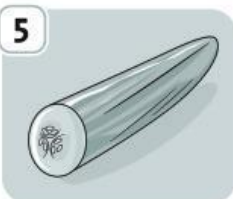

We use **a**, **an**, or **one** before a singular countable noun.

an onion, **a** mushroom, **one** melon

We can use numbers or **some** before plural countable nouns.

three onions, **two** mushrooms, **some** melons.

We use **some** before uncountable nouns.

Uncountable nouns don't have a plural form. We don't use **a** or **an**.

some iced tea, **some** meat

We can use **that** before any noun.
