## FIRST & SECOND CONDITIONAL



### I. Primer Condicional (First Conditional)

Se usa para hablar de situaciones reales o probables en el futuro.

**Estructura: If + presente simple, ... will + verbo en infinitivo.**

Ejemplo: If it rains, we will stay at home. (Si llueve, nos quedaremos en casa).

Se usa para hablar de situaciones hipotéticas, imaginarias o improbables en el presente o futuro.

**Estructura:** If + pasado simple, ... would + verbo en infinitivo.

Ejemplo: If I won the lottery, I would buy a big house.
