

# PRESENT SIMPLE & PRESENT CONTINUOUS

We can use	
the <b>Present Simple</b> to talk about things we do regularly, to talk about routines – what we do every day or every week.	the <b>Present Continuous</b> to talk about things we are doing right now, at the moment.
Examples	
I <b>play</b> tennis every Saturday. My dad <b>makes</b> dinner every day. He <b>doesn't</b> make lunch. We <b>don't</b> play chess after dinner.	I <b>am playing</b> hockey. She <b>is running</b> now. He <b>isn't watching</b> the football match now. We <b>aren't doing</b> sports at the moment.
