Tips on when to use *its* and *their*:

- The possessive pronoun *its* is used for noun in the singular. e.g. *The ambulance provides its service to the community.*
- The possessive pronoun *their* is used for noun in the plural. e.g. *The volunteers offer their services to the flood victims.*
