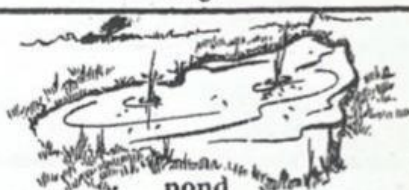

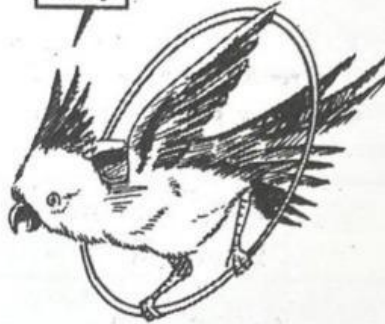

There are special names given to them.

What are these names?

They are 'Poh Wah', 'Polly', 'Hong Kong' and 'Mount Fuji'.

Notice that all these words begin with a capital letter.

Such words are called **Proper Nouns**.

A **Proper Noun** is the special name given to a person, place, thing or an animal.
