|------------------------|-------------------------------------------------|--------------------------------------|
| <b><i>Uses</i></b>     | When we focus on time<br>( <b>since – for</b> ) | When we focus on numbers             |
| <b><i>Forms</i></b>    | Has / have + been + v ( ing)                    | Has / have + p.p                     |
| <b><i>example</i></b>  | I have been running for one hour                | I have ran three time last week      |
| <b><i>Question</i></b> | <b>How long</b> have you been running?          | <b>How many</b> times have you ran?  |
| <b><i>negative</i></b> | I haven't been running for one hour             | I haven't ran three times last week  |

| <b><u>For</u></b>                                           | <b><u>Since</u></b>                                           |
|-------------------------------------------------------------|---------------------------------------------------------------|
| To indicate the duration of the action                      | To indicate when the action began                             |
| Example:<br>For two months, for a year ,<br>for a long time | Example:<br>Since last year , since yesterday ,<br>since June |
