Components of the Environment

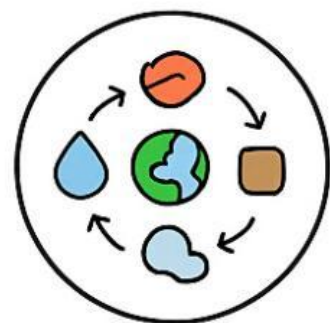
Abiotic Factors	Biotic Factors
   light, air, water, soil.	   humans, plants, animals microorganisms

In addition to the continuous interactions (exchange) that exist between water, soil, air, humans, and other living organisms.

Characteristics of the Environment

1. The environment is a complete system

(It consists of physical elements and biological/living elements that interact with each other to form the components of the environment).



2. The environment is affected

(It is influenced by a group of variables surrounding humans and living organisms).
