Come to Arica – but leave your umbrella at home!

Do you know that the Dry Valleys of Antarctica have no rain at all, and scientists study this area because it is similar to the planet Mars? But the driest city on the planet is Arica, in the north of Chile. It's a great place if you don't like rain because it receives only one or two millimeters of rain a year.

There are hardly ever any clouds over Arica, and the reason it is so dry is because it is close to the Atacama Desert. In some parts of the desert, there are no plants at all.

Arica is the most northern city in Chile. Many American students come here to do short courses to learn Spanish. It has some of the best beaches in the country, and the temperature of the water is ideal for swimming and surfing. Travel south and the water is too cold to swim in because it's nearer to Antarctica.

Chile is not a cheap country to travel in, but Arica is one of the cheapest places in the country. Also, the people here are very friendly and no one worries about rain!
