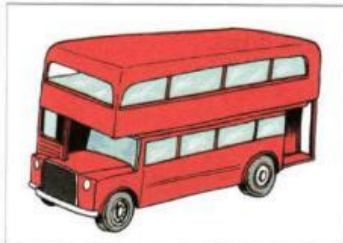
First, we went to a zoo. In the zoo we saw a huge lizard. Some of the children were very (3) but I loved it!

I had a great day!

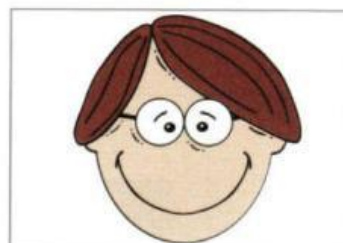
