Diners dip the noodles and herbs into the broth with the grilled pork, creating a harmonious blend of sweet, salty, sour, and savory tastes. In Hanoi, Bun Cha is a lunchtime favorite, enjoyed both in street food stalls and small restaurants. It has become even more iconic since the "Obama meal", attracting tourists eager to experience an authentic taste of Vietnam.
