✅ Quand on utilise 'the' :

- Pour parler de choses précises (ex: I like the book on the table).
- Lieux uniques (the sun, the moon, the sky).
- Noms géographiques (the United States, the Alps, the Nile).
- Instruments de musique (She plays the piano).
- Certains lieux publics (go to the cinema, go to the park).

❌ Quand on n'utilise pas d'article :

- Pour parler en général (I like cats).
- Devant les repas (We have breakfast at 8 o'clock).
- Sports et matières (I play football / I study English).
- Certains lieux dans leur fonction (go to school, go to work, go to bed).

👉 **En résumé : 'the' = précis ou unique / '-' = général.**
