Tony's birthday



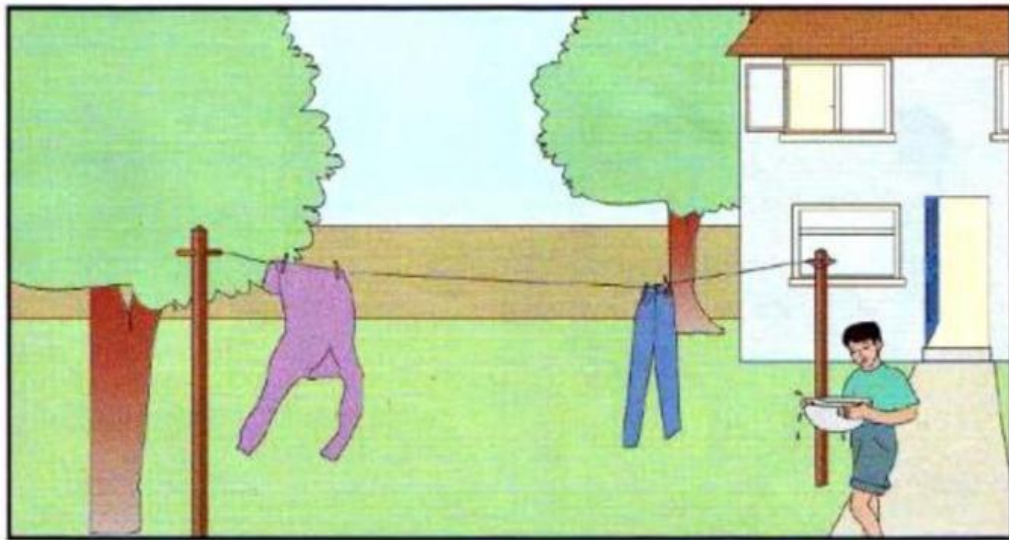
