My name's Jamie Smith. **I'm from** Britain.
I'm fifteen years old. **My address is** 19 Mill Street, Bristol. **My phone number is** 0207 733 1587 (oh, two, oh, seven, seven, three, three, one, five, eight, seven.)

to be (Глагол to be)

Мы можем использовать глагол **to be**, чтобы рассказать о себе.

Утверждение <i>I am from Argentina.</i> <i>You/We/They are sixteen years old.</i> <i>He/She/It is from Canada.</i>
Отрицание <i>I am not from Bulgaria.</i> <i>You/We/They are not twenty years old.</i> <i>He/She/It is not from Italy.</i>
Вопрос <i>Am I a student?</i> <i>Are you from Spain?</i> <i>Is she a teacher?</i>
Краткие ответы <i>Yes, I am. No, I'm not.</i> <i>Yes, you are. No, you aren't.</i> <i>Yes, she is. No, she isn't.</i>

Wh-questions (Специальные вопросы)

Спрашиваем о чём-либо: **What's** your name / telephone number / address?

Спрашиваем о местах: **Where** are you from?

Спрашиваем о возрасте: **How old** are you?

Спрашиваем о людях: **Who** is my teacher?

Subject pronouns and possessive adjectives (Личные местоимения и притяжательные прилагательные)

Личные мест. (всегда подлежащ.)	Притяж. прил. (+ сущ.)
I'm a student.	My name's Jamie.
You are in my class.	What's your name?
He's a teacher.	His name is Colin.
She's from London.	Her telephone number is 0207 8665 8864.
It is 13 Mill Street.	Its name is Bath School.
We're from Britain.	Our teacher is Sarah.
You are in my class.	Your teacher is Tom.
They are in your class.	Their names are Anna and Karol.

Imperatives (Повелительное наклонение)

Для выражения просьбы что-либо сделать мы используем инфинитив без частицы **to**:

Read the text. Listen to the dialogue. Ask and answer questions.

Если мы просим что-либо НЕ делать, то используем **don't** + инфинитив без частицы **to**:

Don't look at the answers.

Don't speak in Russian.

can/can't

Мы используем **can**, чтобы говорить об умении делать что-либо:

I can play the guitar and sing.

I can't ride a horse or swim 100 metres.

Утверждение <i>I/You/He/She/It/We/You/They can swim and ski.</i>
Отрицание <i>I/You/He/She/It/We/You/They can't (cannot) play an instrument.</i>
Вопрос <i>Can I/you/he/she/it/we/you/they play football?</i>
Краткие ответы <i>Yes, I/he/she/we/they can.</i> <i>No, I/he/she/we/they can't. (cannot)</i>
