DURATION

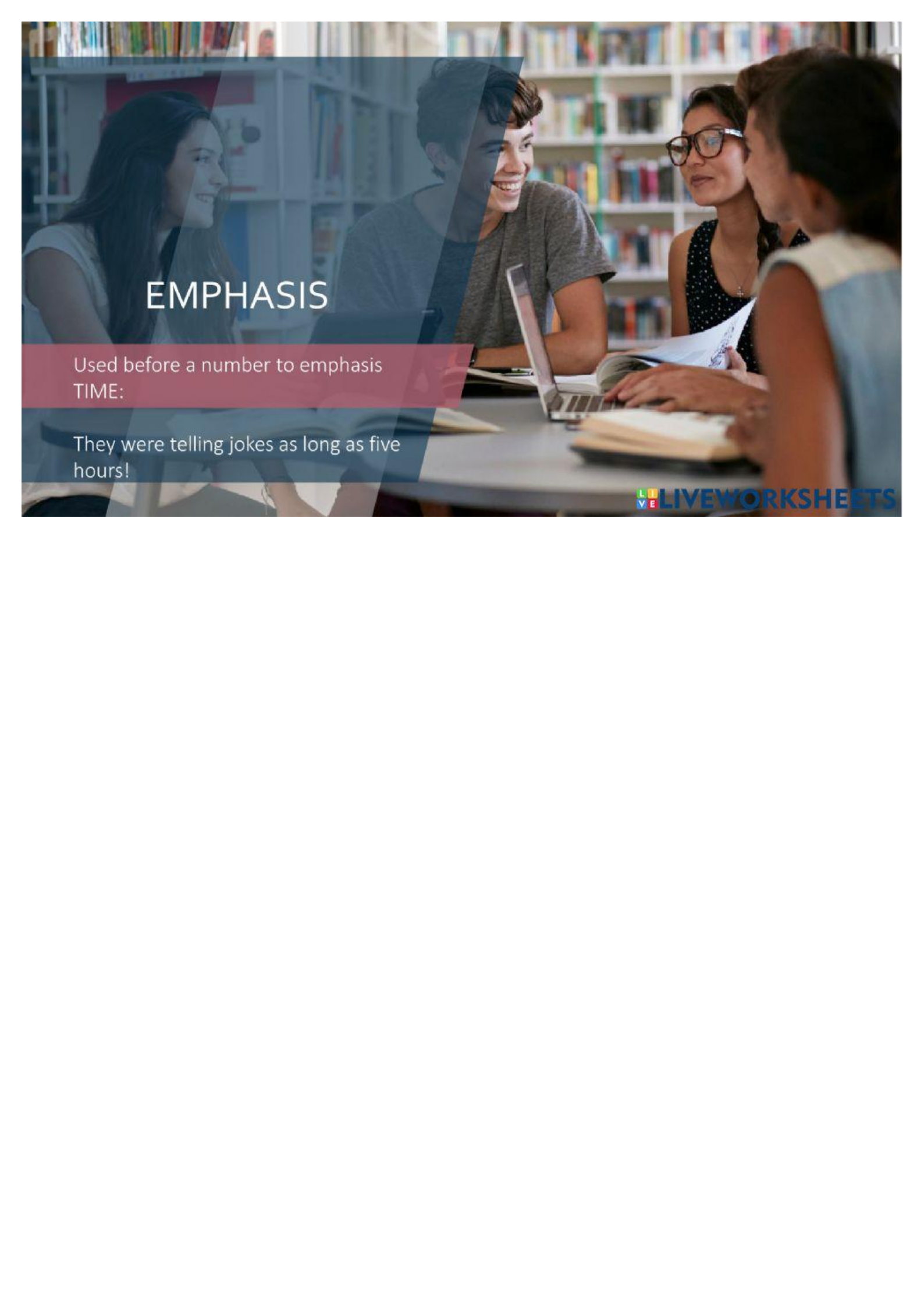
I will be reading as long as you get ready.
