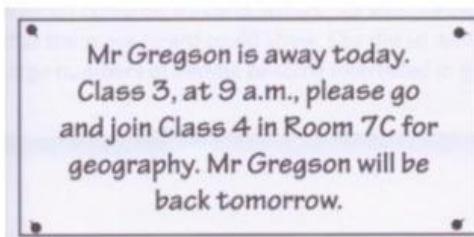

The Rong houses, iconic architectural marvel, have a rich history deeply rooted in Vietnam's Central Highlands. These communal houses are considered a symbol of the region's culture for centuries. The Rong houses are enormous, circular structures which are made from bamboo, wood, and leaves. They often reach the width of 15 meters or more, so it becomes the largest structure in the village. Their high, steeply-thatched roofs are designed to resemble a boat turned upside down. This design is not only for special appearance; it serves a useful purpose by keeping the inside cool in the hot, tropical weather.

The Rong houses serve several **vital** purposes. They are a gathering place for the community. Villagers come together here for important discussions, cultural ceremonies, and festive events. They also preserve and display artifacts and ancestral altars which are the spiritual heritage of the community here.

In the past, only people in the villages can go to the Rong houses, but now they are open to visitors, providing a unique opportunity to experience the rich traditions of Vietnam's ethnic minorities.

The Spanish people made a drink from the cacao beans. The drink cost a lot of money. By 1650, hot cacao was very popular in Europe, but it still cost a lot of money to make. In 1657, the first chocolate house opened in England and sold chocolate drinks to everyone. There was more chocolate in all the shops, so it became cheaper. After 1674, people began to use chocolate in foods like cakes.
