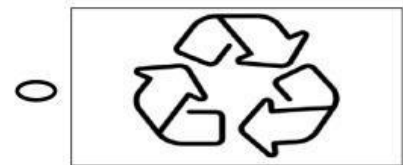

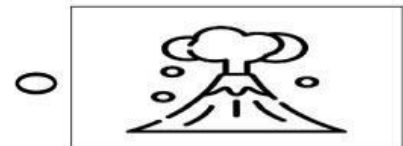
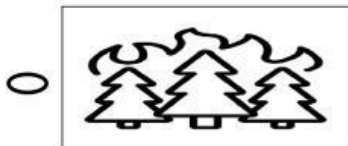

5- A **forest fire** starts when trees and grass burn because of heat. It spreads quickly, destroys homes and forests, and fills the air with smoke. _____
