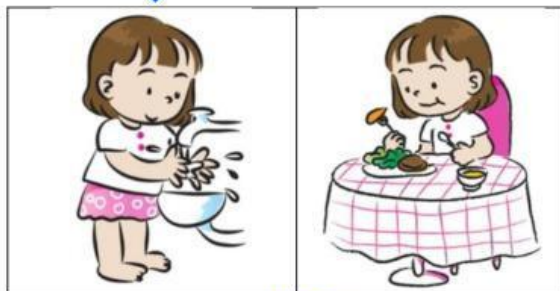


Prepositions of Time («Before» and «After»)

COMPLETE THE RULE. Study the sentences **a** and **b** from the **LEAD IN** activity and **choose the correct option** to complete the rule below.

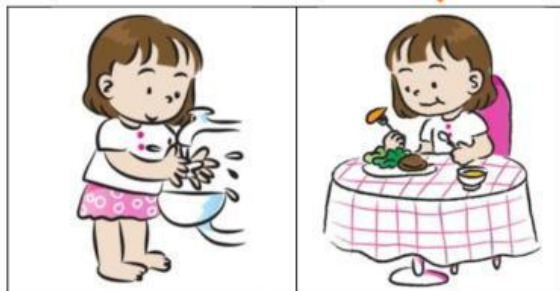
LEARN THIS! before / after

a. The word «before» / «after» means something happens first, and then something else happens later:



*I wash my hands **before** I have dinner.*

b. The word «before» / «after» means something happens later, when something else is finished:



*I have dinner **after** I wash my hands.*
