The **n** sound can be spelled with **kn** or **gn**, as in knew and sign. The **r** sound can be spelled with **wr**, as in wrote.
The **f** sound can be spelled with **gh** or **ph**, as in rough and phone. The **k** sound can be spelled with **ch** or **ck**, as in school and wreck.


