

Sterility:	molecule that stimulates an immune response.
Transmitted:	state of being subject to death.
Infection:	a disease-causing organism including bacteria.
Antigen:	Physiological inability to affect sexual reproduction in a living thing.
Pathogen:	passed on from one person or place to another.
Antibody:	a disease caused by microorganisms that invade tissue.
Endemic:	disease regularly found among people.
Mortality:	specialized Y-shaped protein that tags antigens for destruction.
