



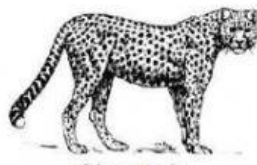

When comparing a group of **NOUNS** (animals, persons, objects) we use Superlative Adjectives.



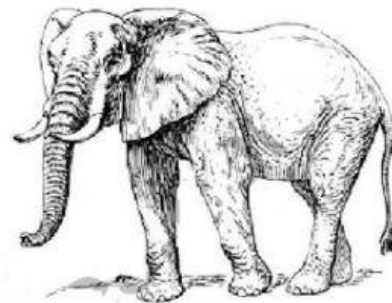
Cheetah

Rules



One syllable	Two syllables ending in 'y'	Two or more syllables
Form: the ... +est	Form: the ... +iest (change y to -iest)	Form: the most ...
the biggest the smallest the tallest	the heaviest the friendliest the happiest	the most beautiful the most interesting the most difficult

One syllable ending in -e the ... +st	One syllable (consonant/short vowel/consonant) double the last consonant - the ... +est	Common exceptions
the nicest the closest the strangest	the biggest the hottest	good = the best bad = the worst

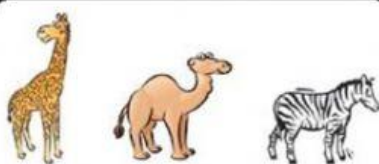
