FORM:

(+) : I / We / You / They / Noun Plural + V + O.

He / She / It / Noun Singular + V-s/-es + O.

Ex: *His friends to music on his phone.*
My dad games.

(-) : I / We / You / They / Noun Plural + DON'T + V bare + O.

He/ She /It / Noun Singular + DOESN'T + V bare + O.

EX: *Her sisters much.*
