



Actividad de Inglés: “Greetings Around the World”

Objetivo:

Investigar y conocer diferentes formas de saludo en el mundo, describiéndolas en inglés y creando un crucigrama con el vocabulario aprendido.

Parte 1: Investigación

Instructions (Instrucciones):

1. Work in groups of 3–4 students.
2. Each group must research **12 different greetings** from around the world.
3. For each greeting, write:
 - **Greeting name** (e.g., “Namaste”)
 - **Description** of how it is performed in **English** (e.g., “Hands together in front of the chest and bow slightly”).
 - **Country** where it is used (e.g., “India”)

Example Table (Ejemplo):

Greeting	Description	Country
Namaste	Hands together in front of the chest and bow slightly	India
Cheek kiss	Two kisses on the cheeks, right and left	France

Tip: Students should try to include greetings that are **gestures, words, or cultural customs**, not only the typical “hello”.

Parte 2: Creación del crucigrama

Instructions (Instrucciones):

1. Create a **crossword in your notebook as a draft** using the **12 greetings** you researched.
2. Each word should have a **clue in English**. The clue can be either the description of the greeting or the country where it is performed.



3. Make the crossword **horizontal and vertical**, making sure words intersect like a traditional crossword.
4. Once finished, design your crossword in a piece of paper and give it to your teacher.


Example of Clue (Ejemplo de pista):

- Word: Namaste → Clue: Traditional greeting from India with hands together.

Evaluation (Evaluación):

- Correctness of information (accurate description and country).
- Use of English vocabulary and expressions.
- Creativity and clarity of the crossword.
- Participation of all group members.
