Bear	A big animal with fur; also means to carry something.	The bear lives in the forest.
Scare	To make someone afraid.	The loud noise scared me.
Wild	Living free in nature.	Lions are wild animals.
Gnat	A very small flying insect.	A gnat flew near my face.
Blind	Not able to see.	The blind man has a guide dog.

Arrangement	The way things are placed or ordered.	The flower arrangement looks nice.
Rhinoceros	A big animal with one or two horns on its nose.	The rhinoceros is very strong.
Melon	A big, round, sweet fruit.	I ate a piece of melon for lunch.
Repaired	Fixed something broken.	Dad repaired the chair.
Lemon	A yellow sour fruit.	Lemon juice tastes sour.
Aware	Knowing something.	I am aware that it's late.
Music	Sounds that people make to enjoy or dance.	I like to listen to music every day.
Despair	Feeling very sad or with no hope.	He felt despair after losing his toy.
Final	The last part of something.	The final test is on Friday.
Rare	Not common; happens not often.	It's rare to see a rainbow at night.
Patient	Calm and not angry while waiting.	The teacher is very patient with us.
Clear	Easy to see or easy to understand.	The sky is clear today.
