In Sicuani, people celebrated the Day of the Dead on November 2nd. During these days, families visited the cemetery to remember their loved ones who passed away. Early in the morning, people cleaned, washed, and


decorated the graves with flowers, candles, and photos.



Many families brought, prepared, and shared breads like Tantawawas, sponge breads, cookies, fruits, and drinks. Some people cooked traditional food like pig, chicken and guinea pig roast. Children played, ran, and laughed around while adults talked, prayed, and remembered their relatives.

The day before the Day of the Dead, people in Sicuani worked hard in the bakeries. Early in the morning, bakers mixed the flour, sugar, and eggs to make the special breads called *tantawawas*. They shaped the dough into figures of babies and animals, and decorated them with colorful candies.

The Day of the Dead in Sicuani was a special time to remember, respect, and celebrate life. It showed how people in our town kept their traditions alive with love and faith.
