Investigate the site, its mission and its contact information.

2

Headlines can be crazy to get clicks. Investigate more. What is the whole story?

3

Do a quick search on the author. Is he/she credible? Is he/she real?

4

Click on those links. Determine if the information supports the story.

5

Reposting old news stories doesn't mean they're relevant to current events.

6

Is it too crazy? Is it satire? Research the site and author to be sure.

7

Consider if your beliefs affect your judgement.

8

Ask a librarian, or consult a fact-checking site.
