Pick the correct future form (or forms) for each of these sentences.

1. Look at that man with the mask on. Do you think he **is going to rob / is robbing / will rob / robs** a bank?
2. I **am going call / will call / am calling / might call** you if I hear any news about Carl.
3. Everything's decided. First, we **have / are going to have / are haveing / will have** dinner at the Italian restaurant. Then, we **drive / will drive / might driving / are going to drive** to Margate to meet Bob and Karen, and we **will all go / are all going to / are all going / all go** bowling.
4. Do you think I **will ever win / am ever going to win / am ever winning / ever win** the lottery?
5. "Why are you all dressed up, Maggy?" "Because I **might go / will go / am going to go / go** to the opera." "Oh. You **will see / might see / are seeing / see** Sally there. She **goes / will go / is going / might be going** with her friends from work."
6. "Mum, I've got a headache"; Oh dear, don't worry "I **am going / will get / am getting / get / might get** an aspirin for you."
7. "Why are you carrying those ladders, Rob?" "I **might climb / will climb / am going to climb / climb** that tree. And then, I **cut / am going to cut / will cut / am cutting** off that old branch because it's dangerous. It **is falling / will fall / is going to fall / might fall** off and hurt someone walking below."
8. "In about fifty years from now, people **will travel / are travelling / are going to travel / travel** by flying car" "No, they **won't / aren't / aren't going to / don't**. That kind of technology **probably is going to be / probably won't be / probably isn't / probably isn't being** available for at least another hundred years."

9. **We go / We are going / We will go / We are going to go / Let's go** and get a birthday card for Wendy.
It **will be / is going to be / might be** her birthday next week.
10. **Might you catch / Will catch you / Are you going to catch / Do you catch** the train to work this morning?" No. I think it **will rain / is going to rain / rains / is raining,** so I **will probably drive / am probably going to drive / probably drive / am probably driving** there.
11. "**Might you throw / Will throw you / Are you going to throw / Do you throw** away that jacket?" "Yes. Look at it! The lining is all torn" "Don't throw it away. I **will mend / am mending / mend / am going to mend** the lining and then I **am taking / might take / am going to take** it to that charity shop in Newark."
