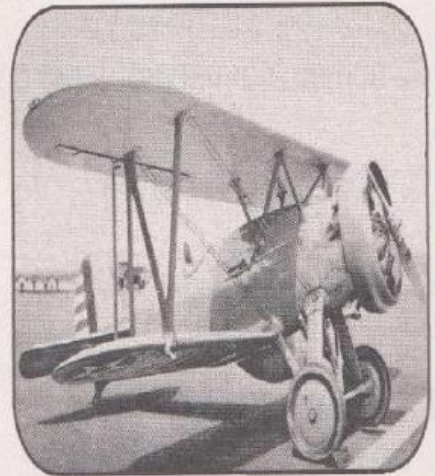
## Proofreading
