

Cassowary is the third tallest and second heaviest living bird. It has been known to kill humans with slashing blows of its feet, which have long dagger-like nails on the innermost toe. Its females are bigger than males and more brightly coloured. It has a naked blue head protected by a bony helmet.



Weka is also known as woodhen. This flightless bird is native to New Zealand. It is brown in colour and about the size of a chicken. It mainly feeds on invertebrates and fruits. It uses its large reddish-brown beak as a weapon when cornered.
