The suffixes **able** and **ible** usually mean can or able to be. The suffix **ful** means full of or having a tendency to be. The suffix **hood** usually means the state or condition of being. The suffix **ship** means having the qualities of. The suffix **ment** means act of or state of. Before adding the suffix to some words that end in **e** or **y**, drop the **e** or change **y** to **i**, as in **like** + **able** = **likable**, and **fancy** + **ful** = **fanciful**.
