1. This cluster of column cliffs, created by successive flows of lava, is located in the northern coast of northern Ireland. It is a great natural wonder of the United Kingdom.
2. Located at approximately 3,800 m above sea level on the border of Bolivia and Peru, this is considered to be the world's highest commercially navigable lake.
3. These cave formations are limestone deposits that hang from the ceilings of limestone caves.
4. This desert in South America is considered to be one of the driest deserts in the world.
5. One of the world's highest continuously active volcanos found in the Andes Mountains of South America.
6. A spectacular canyon carved by the Colorado river in northern Arizona, USA.
7. A volcanic island, part of the Society Islands of French Polynesia in the Pacific Ocean, surrounded by a lagoon and a barrier reef. At its centre are located the twin-peaks, Mount Pahia and Mount Otemanu.
