Before adding a suffix or ending to a word that ends in a consonant and **y**, change the **y** to **i**, as in **jellies** and **magnified**. If the word ends in a vowel and **y**, add **ed** or **s** without changing the base word, as in **dismayed**.

TIP

Some words are the same in both the singular and plural form. To form the plural of most words that end in **f** or **fe**, change the **f** or **fe** to **v** and add **es**. For some words, including words that end in **ff**, just add **s**. Some words that end in **o** take **es** to form the plural, while others just take an **s**.
