2. This dance form originated in Argentina. It is a couple dance. In Argentina this dance is found in many forms like Salon, Fantasia and Canyengue. _____



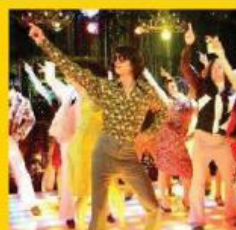
