IRREGULAR VERBS

Irregular verbs in English are those whose conjugation does not end in -ed in their preterite and past participle forms. Therefore, to conjugate them, it is necessary to consider specific rules and exceptions.

The importance of mastering irregular verbs lies in the fact that there are countless examples, from those used daily, such as the verb "to be," to those specialized for different professions and tasks.

It should be noted that irregular verbs fulfill the same functions as regular verbs in English; that is, they express states or actions, and they occupy the same position within the sentence.
