In many parts of the world, cities are trying to become "smart" and "green" at the same time. This means using modern technology to improve daily life **while protecting the environment**. For example, some cities use *smart traffic lights* that change automatically depending on how many cars are on the road. This reduces traffic jams and pollution.

In Singapore, thousands of buildings now have sensors that control air conditioning and lighting. These sensors help save energy by turning lights off when nobody is in the room. In addition, many people use apps that show them the nearest recycling stations or public transport routes.

However, technology alone cannot solve every problem. People still need to change their habits. Using bicycles instead of cars, reducing waste, and reusing materials are simple actions that make a big difference. Smart cities depend not only on smart machines, but also on **smart citizens** who care about the future.

Experts believe that in the next twenty years, technology will become even more integrated into daily life. Homes will be able to recycle water, and most cars will probably be electric. The main challenge will be teaching people to use this technology responsibly and **to understand that sustainability begins with individual choices**.
